Henry Buikema enlisted in the Army in late 1917 and shipped out to France sometime in early 1918 where he was assigned to Battery E of the 101st Field Artillery.

He was killed in action on 30 July 1918 and is buried in the Oise-Aisne veterans cemetery in France.

Henry lived on Jackson Ave with parents Cornelius and Annie, brothers Jan, John, Cornelius, and Garret, and sister Annie.

Prior to service he was a finisher at a carpet mill – likely Beattie's.
