## Raymond Fylstra KIA 28 March 1945

## **Army Technician 5th Grade**



Raymond Henry Fylstra was killed in action on 28 March 1945. He served with the 311<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 78<sup>th</sup> Division.

The 311<sup>th</sup> entered the European theater in December of 1944. They saw action breaking the Sigfried Line (2 fierce night attacks by the 311<sup>th</sup> noted) and of the Roer (311<sup>th</sup> swam and used a single cable). The 311<sup>th</sup> would have been moving with the rest of the division in late March expanding the bridgehead at Remagen.

Prior to service, Raymond lived on Lincoln Ave and worked at Little Falls Laundry.

He was married in 1941 to Evelyn (Eaves) Fylstra.

His parents were Henry and Anna Fylstra. He had two brothers Henry and Daniel.

He is buried in Laurel Grove Cemetery.
