Walter Marron Jr was killed in action on 28 April 1943, possibly in Tunisia. He served with F company, 135th Infantry Regiment, 34th Division. The 34th was in action in Tunisia specifically Kasserine Pass, Fondouk ol Okbi, Hill 609, and Chouigui. Hill 609 took place from 27 April to 1 May. He is buried in the Long Island National Cemetery.

According to the 1940 census, Walter Sr and Ruth Marron lived on Island Ave with child Walter and Walter Sr's father Robert Marron.
